Focus Areas

Health Equity

- Access to culturally relevant information about medical care and/or insurance coverage
- Treatments and/or preventions of substance use disorders
- Access to and/or public awareness efforts about mental and/or behavioral health services
- Public awareness efforts related to chronic disease prevention and/or pesticide exposure

Supporting Immigrant/Migrant/Refugee Communities

- Interpretation services in medical, legal, and educational settings
- Promoting workplace safety and worker rights

Education

- Assistance with accessing financial resources for post-secondary education
- Internships and career opportunities
- Out-of-school time programs (Before and after school, summer programs)

Grant Amount and Duration

- Grant requests can be made for the following amounts:
 - \$5,000
 - \$10,000
 - \$15,000
 - \$20,000
 - \$25,000
- Awards are payable in full at the start of the project period.

2024 YLC Application Required Info

- Organization Info: name, mailing address, phone, website, mission statement
- Contact Info: Name, title, email, phone of authorized person as signatory for grant funds
- Tax Status: 501c3, federally recognized tribe, unit of government, or fiscally sponsored project

- EIN or Tax ID
 - Fiscally sponsored projects should list the EIN or Tax ID of their fiscal sponsor
- Focus Area (select one): Health Equity, Assistance for Immigrant/Migrant/Refugee Communities, Education
- Project Location (select all that apply): Ahtanum, Brownstown, Buena, Cowiche, Eschbach, Glead, Grandview, Granger, Harrah, Mabton, Medicine Valley, Moxee, Naches, Outlook, Parker, Satus, Selah, Sunnyside, Tieton, Toppenish, Union Gap, Wapato, White Swan, Yakama Nation Reservation, Yakima, Zillah
